II. Community Overview

A. Ride-Around summation

A group consisting of Alisa St, Amant, Horn Lake Librarian, Dot France, Friends of Walls Public Library President, and Brian Mitchel, Walls Branch Librarian, performed a ridearound of the area in May, 2007. A detailed route will follow, but the route was designed to show the breadth of the Library's service area, including the Delta Bluffs and Lake Forest subdivisions off of Goodman Rd., Highway 301 which serves as the area's eastern boundary, the Lake Cormorant area six miles south of the Library, and the "old" Walls area east of Highway 61. In the subdivisions, the houses were mostly new, well-maintained properties with many lakeside homes in the Lake Forest area. Outside of the subdivisions, there are apartment communities and trailer parks both within one mile of the library, and working and abandoned farms, mostly in the southern end of the service area. Numerous churches of various size and appearance were observed throughout the service area, with major concentrations along Goodman Road and Church Road. In "old" Walls, there is a neighborhood of modest homes sponsored by Sacred Heart's s housing program. Throughout the service area, there is an absence of service businesses, such as major

grocery stores and fast food outlets. The group observed the area proposed for the Riverbend Crossing development, which, if fully realized, could add 30,000 residents to the area in the next 15 years. Even without Riverbend Crossing's impact, the area is expected to experience rapid growth. The overall appearance of Walls is that of a community in transition—from a primarily rural area to a modern suburban area. It is an area which is struggling to provide services (water, sewer, police, fire, and transportation) for that growing population.

B. History of the library

The Walls Public Library is the newest member of the First Regional Library system. The library opened its doors on July 13, 1998, then known as the James D. "Jake" Pearson Public Library. Amy Gharaibeh (now Poe) was the first Librarian at the facility. The Library opened with slightly fewer than 10,000 books on its shelves. In 2002, the library acquired a neighbor, as the Desoto Health and Wellness Clinic opened their office on the south side of the building. Today, the Walls Library contains over 30,000 items, including books, magazines, videos and DVD's, music CD's, and audio books, and features eight public access computers. The Library anticipates that it will be able to expand its floor space and collection size, as the Clinic will move into the old Southaven Library building in the Spring of 2008.

C. History of the community

Walls is located in Northwest DeSoto County near the Mississippi River. Walls was originally named Alpika, an old Chickasaw Indian word. The name was changed to Walls in 1906.

Walls was named after Captain June Walls who served in the Civil War. Captain Walls was an early settler and merchant of the region in the 1880s.

Agriculture is very important to the Walls economy. Cotton, soybeans, rice and corn are planted each spring. The railroad played a big part in the growth of the area in the early to mid 1900s. The mechanical revolution of the 1950's and 60's changed Walls. With the advent of tractors and modern farming equipment, the face of this community was changed forever.

The Town of Walls, which has been a community since the early 1900's, is connected to the tiny Village of Memphis which was incorporated in the early 1970's and was located just south of the Walls community. In 2003, the Village of Memphis annexed a large portion of the Walls area, and the Governor accepted a petition to grant the Town of Walls the official status of a municipality.

Today, Walls faces the prospect of rapid growth. A new elementary school and middle school have opened within the past year in the Lake Cormorant area. The Riverbend Crossing development, which is planned in southwest DeSoto County, could mean the addition of

30,000 new residents over the next 15 years. The boundaries for this project run from Star Landing Road to the North, Hwy 61 to the West, the Tunica County line to the South, and the Mississippi River to the West. The project includes planned communities, golf courses, and tourist attractions, and promises long-term changes to the area. In the more immediate future, there are housing developments arising along Goodman Road and Church Road.

Walls' efforts to annex areas along Goodman Road have been stymied due to legal threats by surrounding municipalities. Walls is currently seeking to annex homes in the northern part of DeSoto County, near State Line Road.
